## Hours of Work

The brewery's schedule is dictated by the pace of brewing, fermentation and conditioning of the product and is therefore not entirely predictable. You will normally work within standard industrial hours but will be flexible enough to undertake shifts outside these hours at times when the production timetable so dictates.

While we expect a certain level of flexibility in work schedules, in return we offer as much flexibility as is practical. We operate on a weekly rota for production staff.
